At EcoNova, we want you to feel confident in the quality, texture and finish of every product before placing a bulk order. Our sampling process allows you to assess the materials and confirm that they meet your requirements.

- **Fabric Swatches:** Small fabric swatches are available free of charge, allowing you to assess the colour, weave and feel of the material.
- **Reference Sample Assessment:** You may provide us with an existing product sample for evaluation. Our manufacturing team can assess its quality, composition and thread count to help us develop a comparable product at factory price.
- **Full Product Samples:** Full product samples can be provided for evaluation, subject to specification and project requirement.
- **Turnaround Time:** Samples are typically dispatched within approximately 15 business days of confirming your requirements.
- **Shipping:** EcoNova covers domestic shipping costs. International shipping costs are the responsibility of the customer and will be quoted before dispatch.
- **Custom-Development Samples:** A development fee may apply to samples involving bespoke fabric blends, thread counts, colours or designs. This reflects the additional time and materials required for custom production.
